GDPR Privacy Policy

Introduction

This website is maintained by Ronan Clarke on behalf of Slackline Dublin for the purposes of data protection legislation, Shane Keran is the Data Protection Officer. We are committed to protecting your privacy and processing your personal data in accordance with the Data Protection Act (DPA) 1988 up to 24 May 2018 and the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) on and from 25 May 2018 (Data Protection Legislation). This policy explains how the information we collect about you is used and kept securely. It also explains your privacy choices when using our website as well as your right to access your information under Data Protection Legislation. By using the Slackline Dublin Website, you consent to the data practices described in this statement.

The information we collect about you.

We may collect the following information about you through our membership registration process (Google Forms) and our website.

- Your name, email address, address and any other information you voluntarily provide to us via our online forms for the purpose of registering you as a member of our club or/and entering you in an event that you have chosen to participate in.

How we use your information.

We may use your personal information for a number of lawful purposes, including:

- To process and manage your membership.
- To deal with your requests and enquiries.
- To contact you for reasons related to your enquiry.
- To notify you about club events, competitions or products.
- Communications made by the club to its members such as, but not limited to general announcements and newsletters (of which the ability to opt out will be provided).
- Data may be shared with Google LLC for the purpose of utilising their applications for data storage. Slackline Dublin will not be share data with any other Third party unless required to do so by law.

Protecting your information.

The data we collect from you will be transferred to a destination external to the Slackline Dublin website. We will not transfer your data outside of the European Economic Area. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all reasonable steps to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy. The Internet is not generally a secure medium for communication and therefore we cannot guarantee complete security of any information you send to us over the Internet.



Finding out what information this club holds about you.

Under the Data Protection Legislation, you can ask to see any personal information that we hold about you. Such requests are called subject access requests. If you would like to make a subject access request, please contact the club Data Protection Officer (shanekeran@gmail.com). You may also need to provide two forms of identification, for example, driving licence, utility bill or passport and, if appropriate, any particulars about the source or location of the information you are requesting. Your club has 30 days to respond to your subject access request.

Data retention.

Any data that we collect from you will be deleted in accordance with timescales set out below:

Type of Data	Time of removal
Name, email address, address.	Up to 3 months after membership has been revoked/terminated.
Membership forms	One year on the receipt of a new annual membership or not
Event participation form	Indefinite record
Competition results	Indefinite as a record of club sporting results

Complaints.

If you have any concerns or complaints in relation to how Slackline Dublin collects and/or processes your personal data, you should contact the Data Protection Officer in the first instance. If you are dissatisfied with how your concern/complaint is dealt with by this club, you have the right to report your concern/complaint to the Data Protection Commissioner (www.dataprotection.ie).
